READ God's Word together: Acts 2:42 - "They devoted themselves to the apostles' **teaching** and fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers"

Watch a video about the early church by Bryan and Freddy from R-Kidz

EXPLORE together with Reflective Questions:

Jesus told people about good ways to love and help one other, just as he had shown them. The 12 apostles told others about these good ways. Does God want everyone, everywhere to hear about this? Yes! This is called *The Great Commission*. As the apostles traveled, they shared with many people about how God had kept promises, how Jesus could be their friend and how the Holy Spirit could help them. Then, people of all ages started meeting together to keep talking about God, Jesus and the Holy Spirit. *What happened next?* More people became interested in what was being shared and saw how the believers were loving and helping others. Then, they too started to meet together! We also come together to share about God, Jesus and the Holy Spirit. Sometimes we meet at church, at home and sometimes we meet online. We gather together to read the Bible, to learn, listen, sing, talk and pray with each other. In what ways have you and your family met with fellow believers over the past year?
