Pentecost - Family Faith Moment 3

READ God's Word together: Acts 2:42 - "They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and **fellowship**, to the breaking of bread and the prayers".

Read this verse together. Here is a video about Jesus helping some friends

EXPLORE together with Reflective Questions:

What work have you done with others? Have you ever raked leaves in the Autumn with your family or helped plant something in the garden? When working in the garden or anywhere else, it's always helpful to have someone else to do the work with! *Who has helped you do work?* Jesus's friends Simon, James and John worked together on boats catching fish. Once, when Jesus was with them, they caught so many fish that they had to help one another pull the heavy nets full of fish onto one of the boats (Luke 5:1-11). When the apostles, in the early church, had fellowship together, they worked together, talked together and helped one another. Their work was telling people about God, Jesus and the Holy Spirit. They talked with one another about their joy in being friends with Jesus. They helped one another, like Jesus helped them. They built one another up just like in our action song today! As they worked, talked and helped one another they were doing what Jesus showed them to do.
