Pentecost - Family Faith Moment 4

READ God's Word together: Acts 2:42 - "They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and fellowship, to the **breaking of bread** and the prayers".

Read this verse together. Here is a video about Passover by Crossroads Kids Church

EXPLORE together with Reflective Questions:

What special meals do you have? Jesus had a special meal with his closest friends. They were remembering how a long time ago people were safe because God had rescued them. What is that meal called? Even though a lamb was usually in the meal, this time there was no lamb. Jesus took some bread, broke it and gave it to his friends. He poured some drink which he also shared. Jesus told his friends they will see how God sent Jesus. Their hearts would be sad, would get better and then would be made clean. "So, whenever you eat and drink, remember." Jesus said, "I've rescued you!" (pg. 292 The Jesus Storybook Bible). How do you think Jesus's friends were feeling when they heard this? The people in the early church were breaking bread along with teaching, fellowship and prayer. This was no ordinary meal. They were remembering Jesus's life, death and resurrection. They were giving thanks for Jesus and wanted to follow Jesus's ways.
