

Christmas Ornament All-age Craft Activity

This activity is designed to be done by the entire church family, to encourage connections between different generations, and provide a fun prayer prompt for those taking part.

You may choose to do this activity as part of a worship service, or as you see working best for your situation! You may focus on one Advent theme, or use this activity throughout Advent.

We suggest printing the template on cardstock, as this will ensure they maintain their shape.

Directions:

Print off templates on cardstock, and distribute so that each member has an ornament.

Invite members to write their name on the back, along with any specific prayer request they may have. They may also decorate the front (if using the blank template).

Punch a hole in the top, and tie a ribbon or string through to allow for hanging.

Invite people to exchange their ornament with another person, ideally from another age group. Then invite everyone to take their buddy's ornament home, and hang it on the Christmas tree as a reminder to pray for that individual.

We trust that this activity will provide opportunities for meaningful interactions to occur across the generations represented in your faith community!
