SUNDAY, DEC I

I wonder... what do you hope for this Christmas? Pray: Thank you, Jesus, that you have been with God from the beginning.

MONDAY, DEC 2

I wonder... of all the things God created, what is your favourite? Pray: Praise you Lord, for all of the things you have created.

TUESDAY, DEC 3

Read: John 1:3-5

I wonder... What is the oldest thing your family owns? Pray: Thank you, that we can be part of God's big story.

WEDNESDAY, DEC 4

Read: Isaiah 9:2 I wonder… how does it feel to walk in the dark? Pray: Thank you Lord, that you had a great plan all along.

THURSDAY, DEC 5

I wonder... does our family have any favourite Christmas traditions? Pray: Lord, may we know a sense of belonging in God's big family.

FRIDAY, DEC 6

Read: Isaiah 7:H I wonder... what does it feel like to know God is with us? Pray: Thank you God, that you are with us at all times.

SATURDAY, DEC 7

Read: Luke 1:29-31

Read: Luke 1:34-35

I wonder... what would it be like to meet an angel? Pray: God, help us to be faithful to you, just like Mary was.

SUNDAY, DEC 8

Read: Luke 1:26-28

I wonder... what might Mary be feeling? Pray: Give us courage when we face challenges, oh Lord.

Read: Luke 1:32–33 I wonder... what do you think is the greatest thing about God? Pray: Thank you God, for all the areat ways you love us.

TUESDAY, DEC 10

I wonder... what is the biggest surprise you've had? Pray: Help us God, to be open to being surprised by you!

Read: Luke 1:37-38 I wonder... what Mary may have thought about after the angel left? Prav: Thank you God, that nothing is impossible for you!

THURSDAY, DEC 12

I wonder... how Joesph reacted to the news that Mary was pregnant? Pray: God, help us to trust you, even when things feel really tough.

Read: Matthew 1:20-21 I wonder... do you know what your name means? Pray: Thank you for being Immanuel-God with us.

SATURDAY, DEC 14

Read: Matthew 1:22-25 I wonder... what do you think Joseph thought when he first woke up? Pray: God, help us to listen to your voice, and obey you.

Read: Luke 1:39-42 I wonder... what it might feel like to be filled with the Holy Spirit? Pray: May we be filled with excitement for you, Lord!

Read: Matthew 1:18-19

I wonder... what's the longest trip you have been on? Pray: We praise you for keeping us safe as we journey through life.

I wonder... what would be the worst thing about sleeping in a manger? Pray: Thank you God, that sometimes you do things in unexpected ways!

WEDNESDAY, DEC 18

Read: Luke 2:8–9 I wonder... when have you been terrified? Pray: Help us God, to know that you are with us when we are scared.

THURSDAY, DEC 19

Read: Luke 2:13-14

I wonder... can you imagine being one of the shepherds? Pray: Thank you God, that you came for all of us.

FRIDAY, DEC 20

I wonder... what is your favourite Christmas Carol? Pray: Like the Angels, God we praise you for your goodness! Read: Luke 2:15-18 I wonder... who can we tell about Jesus this Christmas? Pray: God, help us to tell people about you, just like the shepherds did.

SUNDAY, DEC 22

Read: Matthew 2:1–2 I wonder... what emotions do you think the Wise Men felt? Pray: Thank you God, that you guide us and show us the way in our lives

Read: Matthew 2:10–11 I wonder... what is the best present you've ever received? Pray: Thank you, for showing us your love by sending your son Jesus.

TUESDAY, DEC 24

Read: Isaiah 9:6 I wonder... what is your favourite thing about Jesus? Pray: Lord, help us to remember that Jesus was the greatest gift of all.

Read: John I:H I wonder... how can we remember Jesus in our celebrations today? Pray: God, thank you for your son Jesus! Help us to always put Him first.
