

## PENTECOST A Family Faith Moment

Pentecost is often thought of as the birthday of the church! When we celebrate Pentecost. we remember when the Holy Spirit decended on the first believers. and that we too. can experience God's help through the Holy Spirit Reflection Questions:

The first followers of Jesus had to be brave. Can you remember a time when you had to be brave? How did you feel at the time? How did you feel after? What ways can the Holy Spirit help us? Talk about the ways that we might feel or experience the Holy Spirit.

MATERIALS: -Paper squares -PVA or glue -Straws -Wire and beads

The Holy Spirit was like a great wind, so why not create paper pinwheels to celebrate! Learn how to make one here. You could even use red. yellow and orange paper to represent the flames. Other great ideas of celebrating together: -Have a bonfire and toast marshmallows! -Hold a birthday party for the church! Put up decorations. wear party hats. decorate cupcakes-be sure to include candles!
