





BIRD FEEDERS

If possible, find somewhere outdoors to participate in this part of the Family Faith Moment. This could be the beach. a nearby reserve. or even a paddock! Remove your shoes and feel the ground beneath your feet. Read the bible verse together, or alternatively, read the story of creation from your favourite Children's Bible.

Reflection Questions:

What evidence of God's creation can you hear, see, smell or feel? What parts of God's creation are you thankful for? How are we, as a family. caring for God's creation?

MATERIALS:

- -Lard (or dripping) -Wild bird seed mix
- -Raisins
- -Natural Twine
- -Paper Cups

Help care for God's creation by creating a birdfeeder together! In a bowl. place chefade. bird seed mix and raisins. Mix together (using your hands is messy, but lots of fun!)

Punch a hole in the bottom of the paper cup. and then thread the twine through. Tie a knot at the bottom. outside the cup. Tightly pack the seed mixture into the cup. making sure to have the

twine in the centre. Let set in the fridge overnight. Carefully cut the cup and peel it away. and then hang your bird feeder in a tree in your garden! The birds will eat the mixture, and then use the twine in their nest building!
