# The Empty Tomb Family Faith Moment

EQUIPMENT Playdough Tray or board for base Dead leaves Flowers and greenery

Create a 'Resurrection Garden' Begin by shaping your playdough into an empty tomb. Don't forget to create the rolled-away stone! Place your tomb on the base and decorate the garden around the tomb with the dead leaves. You could also add dirt and small stones. Next, fill the empty tomb with the greenery and flowers as symbols of life. As you create, talk about ways that you can celebrate Jesus' resurrection in everyday life.

God of Resurrection Life. remind us of the surprising joy that is found at the empty tomb. In these days at home with one another. surprise us over and over again with joy and fill our homes and our hearts with the life we have because of your Son. our risen Saviour. Jesus Christ. Amen!
